



# Tate's Day Camp Registration Form

## REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

1. Complete the family profile and a separate camper profile for each child. Health forms will be mailed separately and must be returned at least three weeks before your child attends camp.
2. Attach check for registration fee (\$50 per child). This fee is nonrefundable and is paid once for the 2010 season. It is not applied toward camp tuition. Camp T-shirts may be purchased for \$10 each.
3. All camper tuition must be paid THREE WEEKS in advance of the session in which the camper is enrolled and there are no refunds within this three week period.
4. There will be a \$50 per session per family drop fee for cancelling weeks before the tuition due date, and a \$25 per change fee to switch weeks after your registration form is submitted. You may add sessions at any time for no charge provided space is available.

## DAILY CAMP HOURS

1. Structured camp activities are from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
2. Drop-off is from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
3. Pick-up is from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

## LUNCH SERVICE

Tate's Day Camp offers an optional catered lunch service. A menu and prices will be mailed to all registered camp families prior to camp beginning. You must return a lunch card and lunch fees at least a week in advance to sign up for lunches. Campers not ordering lunches will need to bring lunch with them each day.

## SELECTING WEEKS

Although our flexible weekly sign up allows plenty of scheduling freedom for parents, it sometimes creates difficult transitions for campers. Experience shows that campers are much more successful when they attend consecutive weeks. Because of the wide variety of activities we offer, there is often not enough time for a camper to participate in all of them during a single week! **Three-year-old campers must attend a minimum of two weeks of camp.**

## GROUP ASSIGNMENTS AND FRIEND REQUESTS

Campers are placed into age-specific groups based on grade level. In addition to grade level we consider other factors such as the number of consecutive weeks that campers are attending and the boy to girl ratios within each group.

When possible, we try to keep campers who are registering for consecutive weeks in the same primary group. Campers are welcome to pick and choose weeks when enrolling; however, campers not registering for consecutive weeks may be placed into different groups and have different group names and counselors when attending camp.

Counselors take steps at the beginning of each week to help campers meet new friends. If you would like to make a request to be with a specific friend, the request must be reciprocal and requested by both parties before April 1. We will try to honor ONE friend request, only if BOTH parties request each other, are in the same grade level, and are registered for the same sessions. Listing more than one request will void all friend requests. **Friend requests are not guaranteed.**

## CAMPOUTS

**June 25 Camper Only Campout** All campers attending weeks 1, 2, 3, or 4 are invited to sign up for the "Camper Only" campout. There is an additional fee for this event and space is limited. Reservations must be made through the camp office.

**July 23 Family Campout** This event is open to all families enrolling in camp regardless of when they are attending. Reservations must be made through the camp office. Sign up early because space is limited. Campers attending this event must bring at least one parent or guardian with them to the campout.

I understand that there is a \$50.00 cancellation fee per week for dropping weeks after I enroll, and there are no refunds for camp tuition within three weeks of the session(s) in which my child / children is registered. There is a \$25 per change fee to change weeks after this form is submitted. I understand it is my responsibility to contact the camp office in the event I must cancel a session of camp.
